



## Super Bowl Squares

- Super Bowl Squares consists of a grid that has 100 squares for people to enter with one axis being the NFC Championship winner and another axis being the AFC Championship winner.
- Our example has @ as the NFC winner and # as the AFC winner.

## Instructions

1. After all squares have been filled, write the participant's name written inside the box.
2. Write down the Super Bowl team name that corresponds with each axis (so as not to confuse your participants).
3. Next write down numbers 0-9 on individual pieces of paper. Put these numbers in a hat.
4. For each team, draw a number and write it in the box with the # sign corresponding to the axis you are currently filling in.
5. When you are finished, make copies for your participants.
6. For each quarter the ending score will determine the winner. For example, if Team A scores 3 and Team B scores 14, that means you find Team A square with 3 and Team B square 4 and locate the winning square with those number combinations.
